WHY LEARN A SECOND LANGUAGE?

- Learning a second language increases your cultural awareness and allows you to appreciate cultural differences
- Knowledge of a second language helps with employment opportunities
- Learning a second language will help a students study and understanding of English
- Students extend their thinking and reasoning skills and apply these in other areas of learning and in processing knowledge (Delitt, 2002)
- Learning languages is central to developing and using multiple intelligences (Delitt, 2002)
- Using more than one language is a skill of the highest order (Delitt, 2002)
- Students will be able to relate to their local society and culture as well as being able to operate globally (Delitt, 2002).

LANGUAGE CLASS AT HOLSWORTHY

- At Holsworthy High School we offer the opportunity to study **Italian** from Year 8 to Year 12.

- Our language programs incorporate ICT skills, games, songs, role plays, class presentations, film studies and speeches. Students also produce various text types in each language such as writing letters, emails, diary entries and sms. Within the language program students will develop four key skills: Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing.

Stage 4 — Year 8

Is a compulsory year of language study where students will learn Italian

Stage 5 — Year 9 & 10

Language becomes an elective. Students can choose to study Italian

Stage 6 — Year 11 & 12

Students can continue to study their chosen elective from Year 9 & 10 or commence their study of Italian in the Beginners Stage 6 courses.

ASSESSMENT

At Holsworthy we use a variety of assessment tasks to assess students learning and cater for different learning abilities. They vary in content, length and degree of difficulty to suit syllabus requirements for the 3 stages of High School language: Stage 4, 5 and 6.

Assessments include:

- Formal Exams—covering listening, reading, speaking and writing skills
- Written Research Assignments
- Class Presentations
- Speeches
- Group Role Plays
- Informal Class Vocabulary Tests
- Informal Class Practice Tests
- Homework Tasks
