School Learning Support Officers (SLSO's) and Learning and Support Teachers (LaST's)

SLSO's and LaST's work with targeted students with additional learning needs. Members of the Learning and Support Team also work with whole classes, small groups and individuals to support learning in all areas of literacy, numeracy and classroom engagement. Students requiring adjustments or modifications are catered for within the classroom through a collaborative approach between classroom teachers and members of the Learning and

Support Team.

Personalised Learning Plans

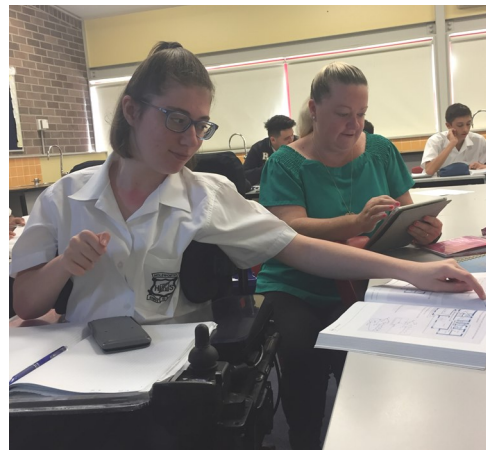
The Learning and Support Team works with identified students, their parents/carers and teachers to create Personalised Learning Plans to enable these students to fully participate in their learning and to achieve curriculum outcomes.

Differentiation of the Curriculum

Staff capacity is continually built through professional learning with strategies to differentiate the curriculum and create accommodations specific to student learning needs. This ensures that all students have access to the curriculum.

Disability Provisions for Assessments

Disability provisions for assessments are provided and adhered to by all staff with the highest amount of support provided to identified students. These students have had the opportunity to complete tasks on time and to the best of their ability with the assistance of SLSO's and Learning and Support Team.



Collection of NCCD data

The school supports the National Consistent Collection of Data (NCCD). This data collection creates opportunities for teachers to engage in professional dialogue about adjustments and modifications for students with additional needs in their classrooms.

Extracurricular opportunities

To develop students confidence, social skills and independence the Learning and Support Team have involved students in a variety of activities including School Spectacular, Sailors with Disabilities, Volunteering and the Community Garden.
